About ASAC

Public Health Ontario (PHO) promotes and supports antimicrobial stewardship as an effective strategy for limiting inappropriate and excessive antimicrobial use in health care, while improving and optimizing antimicrobial therapy and clinical outcomes for patients.

The Antimicrobial Stewardship Advisory Committee (ASAC) is a Program Advisory Committee of Health Protection that advises PHO on matters related to antimicrobial stewardship, taking into account the following:

- PHO's Vision, Mission, Mandate and Values;
- Goals, objectives and scope of PHO's Antimicrobial Stewardship Program; and
- Provincial priorities.

ASAC membership is multidisciplinary in nature. ASAC is currently seeking practitioners (e.g. pharmacist, physician, nurse, nurse practitioner or infection prevention and control practitioner) from the following sectors/professional areas:

- Long-term Care
