Ontario Municipal Tobacco and Vaping Retail Licensing Summary-2024

Published: March 2025

Background

Those who sell tobacco and/or vaping products in Ontario must abide by the rules outlined in the [Smoke-Free Ontario Act, 2017](#), for age restriction, signage, display and promotion, and type of products sold. As of July 1, 2018 all Ontario retailers selling tobacco products were required to hold a provincial tobacco retail dealer's permit issued under the Tobacco Tax Act (TTA).¹ There is no such permit or licensing required for retailers selling vaping products or other nicotine products (e.g. nicotine pouches) in Ontario.

As of January 1, 2020, the Smoke-Free Ontario Act requires tobacconist (at least 85% of the retailer's inventory at the time of registration must consist of specialty tobacco products) and specialty vape stores (at least 85% of its sales from the previous 12 months are from vaping products) to register with their respective local public health unit (no fee associated with this registration).² Tobacconists established prior to 2020 require only 50% of sales to consist of specialty tobacco products.²

The Smoke-Free Ontario Act does not prevent municipalities from imposing stronger local tobacco or vaping control measures. The Act explicitly states that where there is a conflict between its provisions and those of municipalities, "the provision that is more restrictive" prevails.³

The regulatory authority of municipalities in Canada is set by provincial law. In Ontario the [Municipal Act](#) and the [City of Toronto Act](#), provides authority to the 443 Ontario municipalities and the capital city. The Ontario Municipal Act gives local governments broad scope of authority for by-laws concerning 'health, safety and well-being of persons', for 'consumer protection' and for 'business licensing'.⁴

The Smoke-Free Ontario Scientific Advisory Committee (SFO-SAC) 2016 report provided evidence that retailer licenses and retail license fees can increase compliance with in-store tobacco retail restrictions and reduce the number of licensed retailers.⁵

Objective

This summary captures municipal tobacco and vaping retail licensing by-laws in Ontario.

How to Use This Document

The by-laws listed in the table below appear in alphabetical order of jurisdiction.

Legend for items included in the by-laws:

T = Tobacco Products

V = Vaping Products

The licensing fees documented do not necessarily capture total cost for municipal licensing, additional fees and taxes may also be required. Costs may also have changed since the writing of this document.

The list of by-laws does not necessarily capture all by-laws in the province. This first edition was developed using Canadian Cancer Society's Tobacco Retailer Licence Fee Summary⁶ and Physicians for a Smoke-Free Canada's Tobacco Retailing: A scan of available regulatory approaches.⁷

The document will be updated as new and revised by-laws are developed and amended.

Note on Terminology

Any reference to tobacco in this document refers to commercial use of tobacco, which is not associated with the sacred and traditional uses of tobacco, which Indigenous peoples have been using for thousands of years. Traditional or sacred tobacco differs from commercial tobacco both in the way that it is harvested and in the way it is used in ceremony and prayer, often for healing and purifying.
