
What is Influenza Like Illness (ILI)?

ILI is an acute onset of respiratory illness with **fever and cough** and **with one or more** of the following: sore throat, arthralgia, myalgia or prostration (extreme fatigue).

Note: In patients \geq 65, fever may not be prominent. Children <5 years old may also have gastrointestinal symptoms.

What is Acute Respiratory Illness (ARI)?

ARI is a respiratory illness with new or worsening cough.
