

Saliva Collection Kit Instructions Kits with Funnel and Saline Rinse Packet

Note: Saliva collection kits may come with a straw or funnel and may also come either with or without a saline rinse packet, or a cap with blue transport liquid.

- B. Tip your head back and gargle for another 5 seconds.
- C. Repeat A & B for 5 seconds.
- D. Repeat A & B again for 5 seconds.



Make sure test tube is labelled with your:

- full name
- date of collection
- one other unique identifier (e.g., date of birth or Health Card Number)
- A. Unscrew the tube cap and place cap upside down on a clean surface.
- B. Insert the funnel into the tube and make sure it fits snugly into the tube opening.

A. If masked, remove your mask.

B. Open the packet of clear saline

your mouth.

NOTE: Use only the liquid

NOTE: DO NOT SWALLOW.

provided in the packet.





- A. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer.
- B. If you were wearing a mask, put it back on.

A. Using the funnel, slowly and gently spit the saline rinse through the funnel directly into the tube.


Note: Take your time being careful not to splash or spill.


- B. Remove the funnel and discard the funnel.
- C. Screw cap back on the tube.

Note: DO NOT reopen the tube or remove any liquid

- A. Check that the cap is screwed on tight.
- B. With a clean tissue, wipe the outside of the tube and cap.
- C. Check that label is complete (see Step 2).
- D. Place tube in clear biohazard bag, then place completed form in bag's outside pocket.







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
