Private room or 2 metre separation with curtain pulled

Staff - mask and eye protection

Patient / Resident - mask if outside room

CONTACT

Private room or cohort with same (if lab confirmed)

Staff - gown and gloves where appropriate

Dedicated equipment

DROPLET + CONTACT

Combine all elements of both

AIRBORNE

Negative pressure room with door closed

Staff - N95 Respirator where appropriate

Patient / Resident - mask if outside room
